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Our Colorado Programs are located in suburban Denver at the foothills of the Rocky Mountains and offer a wide range of social and community-oriented venues for our residents. Our facilities are just a short drive from Denver International Airport, making it convenient for those traveling from outside the area.

These programs provide a range of services for our residents, including: neurobehavioral rehabilitation, residential rehabilitation and supporting living environments. Therapeutic day activity programs complement the living options by supporting each resident's needs and interests through community-supported productive activities.

All Colorado programs are overseen by a Board Certified Behavioral Analyst and staffed 24 hours per day, 7 days per week.

Program Facilities



Glen Dee House

This program is located in the nearby community from the campus in a pleasant neighborhood setting. The 8-bed house features a large common area and is walking distance to stores and activities in the Denver-Lakewood area. The residence allows Life Skill Trainers the ability to support residents in a real-life, homelike environment and also in the therapeutic day activities at our campus.



Learning Services Neurobehavioral Institute – West

Our newest neurobehavioral rehabilitation program is specifically designed to provide supported living and transitional rehabilitation for adults with complex behavioral challenges stemming from a brain injury. The secure campus environment boasts a 15-bed residence, as well as a large therapeutic activity center.

Program Features

2:1 Direct Care Staffing¹

At the LSNI – West campus, we staff one Life Skills Trainer for every 2 residents. This staffing ratio allows our residents the support they need to effectively support the behavioral complexities caused by a brain injury. Whether supervising every day life skills with the residents or supporting them in therapeutic activities in the community, this ratio provides flexibility for the resident to live, learn and prosper.

Safe and Secure Environment

As a compliment to our staffing ratios, LSNI –West features the latest technology to ensure every resident's safety and security. Many provisions have been made to create a protected environment with great pains not to impede on a resident's ability to take measured risks towards independence.

Clinical and Medical Specialists²

Our programs provide consulting medical and clinical specialists to ensure the health and wellbeing of all our residents. The Colorado program's medical team consists of a Medical Director, who is a psychiatrist; a Neuropsychologist; a Neuropsychiatrist; as well as a Supervising Behavior Analyst. This team works hand-in-hand with the therapeutic team, as well as the direct care staff or Life Skills Trainers.

Therapies on Site²

The Colorado Program offers physical therapy, speech language pathology, occupational therapy, vocational services as well as psychological and nursing services on site. Therapists work with residents to develop practical living skills at the facility in which they live. Not only do residents benefit from learning skills right where they use them, but the therapists train the staff so they can help residents implement their new skills all day long.

Board Certified Behavior Analyst on staff³

Our behavior analyst rounds out our clinical team by working directly with residents who have significant neurobehavioral challenges. This discipline allows our team to support our residents, as well as train the staff on sophisticated behavioral support and management techniques. Systematic monitoring of challenging behaviors and documenting the effectiveness of our treatments provides for better outcomes as a result.

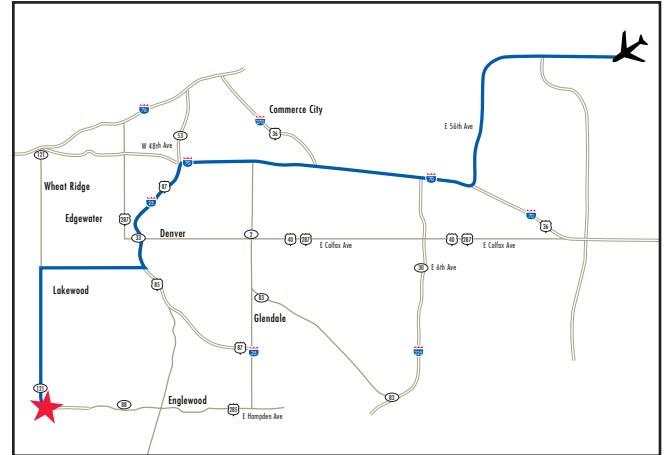
Community-Integrated, Homelike Environments
